We start from up on the high Rannoch Moor pass beside the A82. We have a short drag to begin with then start paddling along Loch Ba. From here we wind our way between small islands looking for the end of the loch and the first bit of river. This is repeated day after day until we are on the mighty River Tay. We will mix a blend of paddling / poling / lining / sailing and portaging skills in this expedition that should be top of everyone's wish list.

Depending on weather / water levels & the group's ability, exact end locations of the trips can vary. Length of the paddling days will again be dependent on weather / water levels & the group's ability but expect to be travelling for a minimum of 6 hours each day.

How hard is the paddling?

The beauty of this trip is that we can paddle as far as we want each day which allows us to take in the history, beauty and wildlife that line our way. It is ideal for all abilities; however some groups may have more portaging than others.

What time of year?

The best time of year is between Easter and October. For those of you who like a little more adventure then taking a tour out of these times can bring some fantastic rewards. We would recommend that outwith these times you should be of an intermediate standard or above. Please check when booking.

What about equipment?

For this trip we will be entirely self supporting and take all our equipment with us. You will require canoe & associated equipment / camping equipment / cooking equipment / food / midge net. We will provide a full kit list at time of booking and advise what we have available for you to use.

How much?
